It Always Comes Down to People

Doing business with government often comes down to understanding the business of government. One of the bigger obstacles facing potential contractors pursuing government opportunities is navigating the subtle nuances happening on the inside of the government process.

Political will, social stigma, public interference, complex financing, environmental constraints, employee motivation, and status quo are among the many, sometimes unseen, roadblocks of government procurement. It is critically important that potential partners from the industry appreciate that these extenuating circumstances, or ignorance to them, can make or break a contracting opportunity.

One solution is relationships. And, the key to any good relationship is listening. Take some time to do

your homework to understand the challenges facing the agency contracting the work. Get to know the players and invest in their issues. This foundation of understanding and support will not only gain the confidence of these contracting entities, but will provide insight to developing proposals that will be on target, appropriate, and appreciative of the challenges of the awarding authority.

There are many ways to approach building strong relationships:

- Research the agency
- Learn their processes
- Attend meetings with key personnel
- Request briefing opportunities
- Offer educational opportunities to government staff
- Share industry insight
- Chase the project, not the money
- Attend meetings, workshops, conferences

While the development of relationships takes time, the return on the investment is outstanding. Be sincere, give time, and listen your way to new opportunities with the public sector.
