One Thing is for Certain - Transportation Investment Keeps America Working

If you walk the halls on Capitol Hill, the air of doubt permeates most conversations. From foreign relations to environmental regulations, there appears to be no solid foundation to lean on as we advance through the first 100 days of the Administration. Even in one of the more common-ground areas of government, the need for improving our nation's infrastructure, there lacks any clear understanding of what funding programs will be on and/or off the table in the coming months.

While uncertainty is the theme of the day, what is certain is that investment in transportation boosts jobs, boosts the economy, and ultimately boosts the quality of life of friends and neighbors. This is no more evident than in a major freeway project in California that opened to the public just a couple weeks ago.

The State Route 91 Project is a \$1.4 billion Express Lane project that extended the proven 91 Express Lanes from Orange County to Interstate 15 in Riverside County and added regular lanes to the 91 between SR 71 and Interstate 15. In the end, more than 320,000 feet of sound walls were added, 110,000 linear feet of new drainage installed, and 32 bridges built.

The numbers that really resonate, however, are the 16,200 jobs that were created, the direct and indirect local purchases in excess of \$60 million, and the nearly 1,300 workers that were on site every day. All for a project that will ultimately free up capacity to move the 280,000 daily commuters to and through the region more effectively while creating better throughput for the 40% of the nation's freight generated from the Ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles.

So, if you're in an industry that supports the delivery of transportation projects like this, there is no better time than now to engage in the conversation to encourage the capital investment programs with your state and federal legislators. At the same time, continue to nurture the relationships that illustrate the readiness of you and your partners in the business.
